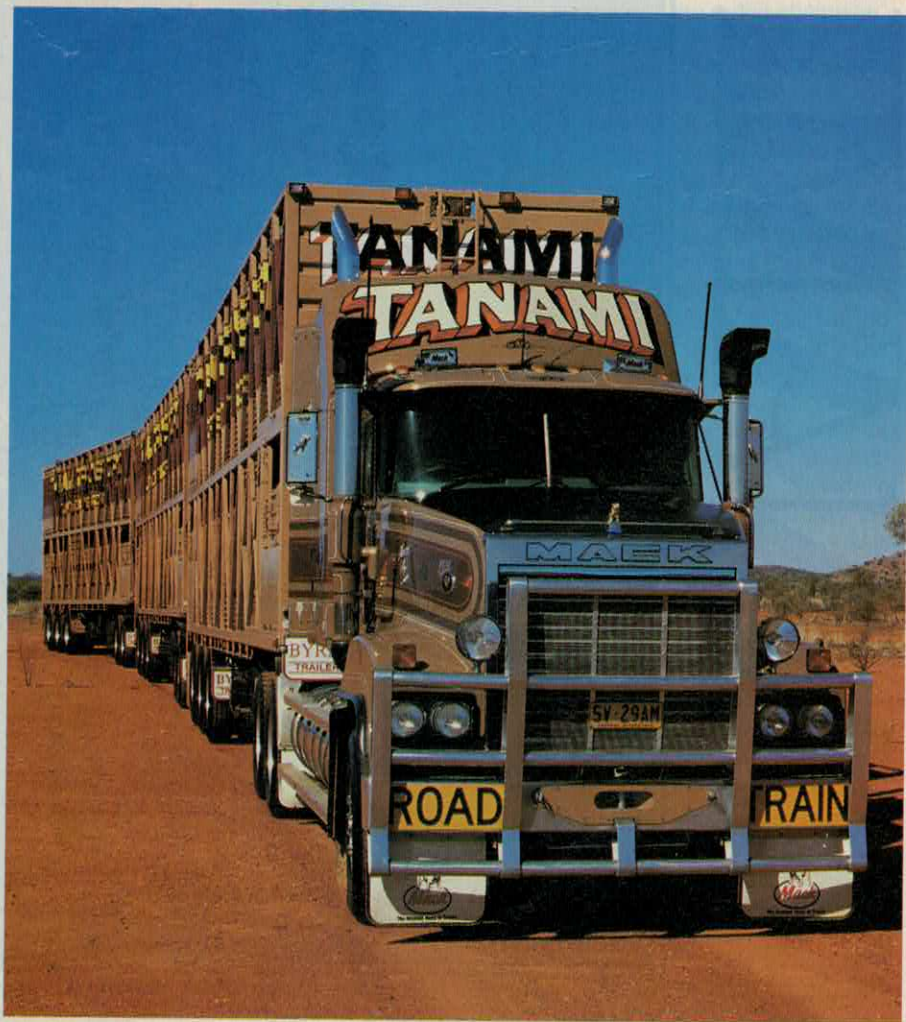
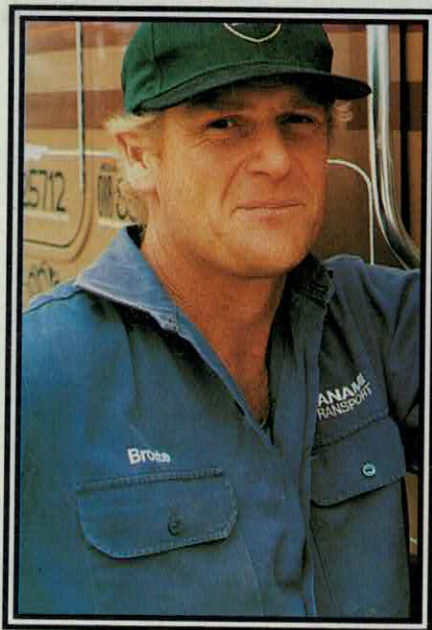


December's Rig of the Month winner is a Mack Titan owned by Alan Rogers. A man of few words, Alan operates Tanami Transport and runs a fleet of seven livestock trucks through some of the toughest country in the Territory. Based in Alice Springs, the Tanami triple roadtrains are a familiar sight throughout Central Australia. Their latest truck, the Mack Titan is driven by Bruce Bronte. Well-specified for the job, the Titan is powered by the 575hp V8 Mack engine delivering a massive 2610Nm torque - plenty of power to make sure the wild beasts make it to market.

The Mack channels its grunt through Mack's T-2180 transmission, down to Neway Air suspension and Michelin tyres. The front axle is Mack's FAW 18.0 with Rockwell 52-180 on the rear. Sheppard power steering helps keep the Bulldog on the road while a Holland FW70 turntable finishes off the specs on this very worthy December winner.
